PYX conducted a survey and collected sample data from the village heads, neighborhood chiefs, artisans, miners, students, entrepreneurs, traders, laborers, and employees covering ages ranging from 17 to 54 years.

The company listened to their concerns and greatest needs and it was clear that improved infrastructure and roads were critical issues.

Local communities subsist largely through agriculture, and safe and reliable roads are very important to their sustainability.

The upgraded bridge, which had been in a state of disrepair for three years, is also critical for local students and their access to schools and further education.

Inspired by the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) set forth by the United Nation's Development Programme, the company has introduced "PYX Cares" as its blueprint for making a difference in the areas where it works and in achieving sustainable growth.
